Main Bible Character: Moses

What is The Glory of God?

The Glory of God being able to see God's greatness.

Lesson

Have you ever seen something that was cool? How about something that was amazing? Now have you ever seen something that was the most amazing and awesome thing in the whole world? What was it?

Did you know that Moses saw the most amazing thing ever? Moses wanted to see what God looked like. He asked God, "Show me what You look like" God said, "I cannot show you my face because no one can see my face and live but I will show you my back."

Moses got to see God's back and to make it even more amazing, God told Moses how good of a God He was.

Moses learnt that God was merciful and gracious.

Personal Application

Christmas Connection:

Moses saw what God looked like from behind because to see His face would have been too much for Moses to handle. When Jesus came as a baby, God showed us what He was like. He was a God that loved us so much that He became a human being so that he could die for us. He died so that we can go to heaven one day.
